

How to use your affiliate links

An affiliate link looks like this:

http://www.concisetraining.net?affiliates=3

The part to the left of the question mark tells the web browser where to go.

http://www.concisetraining.net

The question mark and everything to the right of it <code>?affiliates=3</code> is what identifies the fact that you have referred the visitor to our website. Without the question mark and the information to the right of it, we won't know who has referred that visitor and therefore you will not be allocated any commission!

Examples of link construction and usage

Here x is the affiliate ID and you would replace this with your own affiliate ID.
